FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Elementary Strings – MMSD <u>Budget Update</u>

The 2004-2005 school budget process is underway. On Thursday, March 11th, the Superintendent released his recommendations for \$9.9 million cuts needed to bring next year's budget in line with state imposed revenue caps.

- The Superintendent <u>did not recommend any changes in the elementary strings program</u> at this point in next year's 2004-2005 school budget process. However class sizes are large and growing, which negatively affects students' ability to learn in all academic subject areas.
- The school **<u>budget process is very volatile</u>**, and budget decisions are **<u>not final</u>** until the School Board approves the entire budget, which could be as late as June 2004.
- Last year, the District Administration recommended a fee for Grade 4 strings, which the Board vetoed. <u>The Board did approve all other fees</u>. <u>However, the effect was to *cut the academic curriculum* at the last minute after public hearings were held. The curriculum was cut, but the referendum enabled the curriculum to be re-stored.

Madison Schools Elementary Strings – Additional Information

- *High Demand* nearly <u>2,000 fourth and fifth grade elementary students</u> participate (>50%).
- *Growing Program* Since 1993, 4th grade <u>strings program</u> enrollment <u>increased by 21%</u> while district 4th grade enrollment decreased by 10%.
- *Low-Income Grants* <u>450 low-income fourth and fifth graders receive instrument grants</u> at no incremental cost to the District.
- *Costs Covered* <u>Rental fees cover the costs</u> of new instruments and the repairs for existing instruments.
- *Cost Effective* The <u>entire K-12 music education</u> curriculum costs the District <u>\$238/participant/school year</u> (nearly 20,000 participants). The District spends \$990/participant for elementary math; \$2,000/participant for elementary language arts.
- *Efficient* Elementary string teachers are <u>efficient</u> <u>200 students/full-time strings teacher</u>.
- *Academic Curriculum* Elementary strings are the first two years of the MSMD School Board approved Grades 4-12 instrumental academic curriculum.
